What you'll do for us

The Zero Period team is currently looking to onboard a program coordinator willing to manage the [Teacher Sensitization Program](#) (TSP) and [Teacher Ambassador Program](#) (TAP) implementations, offered by The Zero Period to its beneficiary schools. These programs are designed to train and upskill school teachers to be sensitized to the mental, emotional, social and physical needs of children, further enrolling self-motivated teachers to become trained sexuality educators in their school, taking classes to implement our CSE curriculum for Grade 6. What you can expect from us

Born amidst a global pandemic, The Zero Period is now over a year old. The inception, ideation and program implementation— all has taken place remotely. The team currently consists of two co-founders who work alongside a few experienced sexuality educators to deliver its programs. You can expect a youth-driven, start-up environment where we ideate and implement as we go. The teacher-training program offered by us will give you a unique grassroots exposure of how Indian audience engages with sexuality education. You will be offered support for your creativity, along with a good scope of autonomy during program implementation.

Role requirements

- Organizing programs and activities in accordance with the mission and goals of the organization.
- Developing an evaluation method to assess program strengths and identify areas for improvement.
- Managing a team with a diverse array of talents and responsibilities during the program implementation
